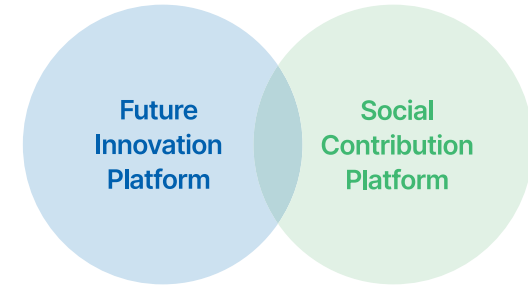

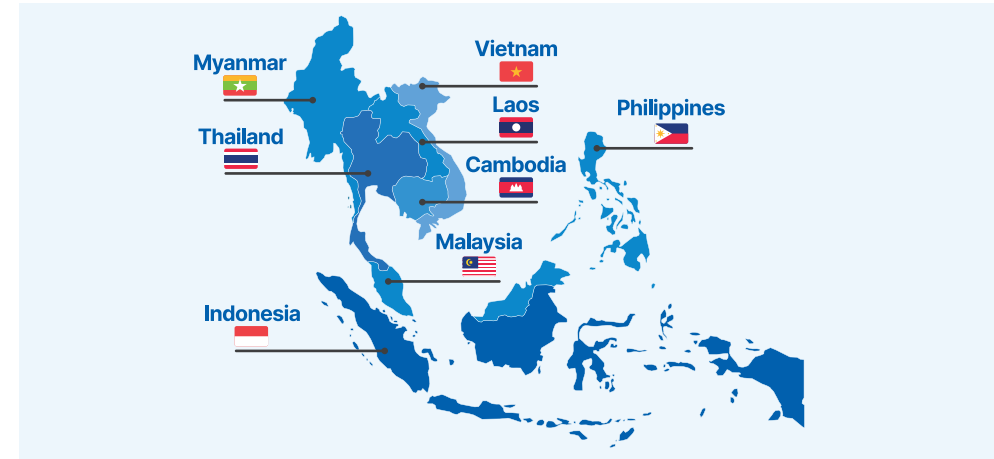

## Global Scholarship

**Target** Students from 8 ASEAN countries, recommended by partner universities  
\*ASEAN : Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam, Philippines

**Eligible Fields** Business administration, Economics, Future Industry (IT, biohealth, energy, etc), Korean Language/Korean Studies, Policy/Public development

**Support Duration**

## Undergraduates Scholarship

**Target** Undergraduate students who are recommended by partner universities and are completed at least the second semester.

- Full tuition for 2 regular semesters(fall/spring semesters) and winter vacation program
- Learning scholarship  
1 million KRW per month
- Settlement scholarship  
2.5 million KRW upon arriving at Korea
- Completion scholarship  
0.5 million KRW per upon completion

**Target** Incoming graduate students who are admitted by a partner university and recommended by the university.
